Child support payments that are received must be included as income regardless of whether or not there is a court order awarding support.

Child support amounts awarded by the courts but not received can be excluded only when the applicant/co-applicant certifies that they payments are not being made and further documents that all reasonable legal actions to collect amounts due, including filing with the appropriate courts or agencies responsible for enforcing payment, have been taken.
